I suppose you have been east anyway. Oh Say, how are you getting along with your school? I suppose you are kept awfully busy and I am sure you will find it very tiresome of course I know just how a teacher feels after the day is finished at least I have an idea. Awfully tired eh, I must thank you for your Christmas wishes and I wish you the same Happy and Prosperous New Year.
